Monsoon Watch

- ❖ A low-pressure area over southwest Bay of Bengal off north Sri Lanka coast, with the associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- ❖ The trough runs from upper air cyclonic circulation over West Madhya Pradesh to north Gangetic West Bengal across East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand at 0.9 km above mean sea level.

Significant Weather

Light rainfall recorded at isolated paces in East Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh and dry weather prevailed over West Madhya Pradesh & Vidarbha. Highest amount of rainfall recorded in mm: Sukma - 10.3mm in Chhattisgarh.

Heat wave experienced at RATLAM (45.5 deg cel) in West MP.

Gusty winds reported at isolated places in the region. Gusty winds recoded at 12 stations (Highest: Khandwa 56 kmph) in West MP, 3 Stations (Highest: Jabalpur 46kmph) in East MP, Koriya 37 kmph in Chhattisgarh and at Lonar -Buldhana 41 kmph in Vidarbha.

Maximum Temperature

No large change in Maximum temperature in past 24 hours.

Temperature Departure: Appreciably below normal over Chhattisgarh, Below Normal over East Madhya Pradesh and Normal over West Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha.

The highest maximum temperature of 45.5°C was reported at RATLAM.

F/C : RISE IN MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE BY 2-4 DEGREE CELSIUS IN NEXT 5 DAYS, THEREAFTER NO LARGE CHANGE IN NEXT SUBSEQUENT DAYS OVER THE REGION.

Minimum Temperature

Minimum temperature appreciably rise in Chhattisgarh and No large change observed in rest parts of the region, in past 24 hours.

Temperature Departure: Below normal over Chhattisgarh and Normal over rest parts of the region.

The lowest minimum temperature of 20.8°C was reported at AMBIKAPUR.
