Synoptic observations	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ The Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some parts of Northeast Arabian Sea, Gujarat & Madhya Pradesh, remaining parts of Maharashtra, and some more parts of Chhattisgarh & Jharkhand, today the 24th June, 2026. ❖ The Northern Limit of Monsoon passes through 20°N/60°E, 20°N/65°E, 20°N/70°E, Surat, Indore, Mandla, Daltonganji, Motihari and 28.3°N/83°E as on 24th June. ❖ Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, remaining parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand & Bihar, some parts of Uttar Pradesh during next 2-3 days; some more parts of Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh, and some parts of Uttarakhand during subsequent 2-3 days. ❖ The seasonal trough at mean sea level from Rajasthan to Gangetic West Bengal across north Madhya Pradesh, south Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Jharkhand persist. ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over central Parts of Madhya Pradesh lies over southeast parts of Madhya Pradesh at 3.1 km above mean sea level. ❖ The trough runs from the above cyclonic circulation over central parts of Madhya Pradesh to East Central Arabian Sea now seen from southeast parts of Madhya Pradesh to Eastcentral Arabian Sea across North Maharashtra at 3.1 km above mean sea level.

Light to Moderate rainfall was observed at many places and heavy rain at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh. Light to Moderate rainfall was observed at few places over west Madhya Pradesh.

Maximum Temperature	
No large change in maximum temperature observed over Madhya Pradesh and Chattisgarh and appreciably fall in Vidarbha. Temperature Departure: Normal over Madhya Pradesh and Above normal over Vidarbha and Chattisgarh. The highest maximum temperature of 41.2°C was reported at Datia (West Madhya Pradesh) and Sidhi (East Madhya Pradesh). Forecast: No Large Change in Max Temp. next 3 days Thereafter gradual rise by 2°C over Madhya Pradesh. No Large Change in Max Temp. for next 7 days in Vidarbha region. No Large Change in Max Temp. for next 5 days in Chattisgarh.	
Minimum Temperature	
No large change in minimum temperature in past 24 hours over Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha. Temperature Departure: Normal over Madhya Pradesh and Chattisgarh. Below normal over Vidarbha region. The lowest minimum temperature of 20.0°C was reported at Damoh (East Madhya Pradesh).

27-Jun-2026 (Day 4)	THUNDERSTORM ACCOMPANIED WITH RAIN,LIGHTNING, GUSTY WINDS (SPEED REACHING 40-50 KMPH) LIKELY AT ISOLATED PLACES IN MADHYA PRADESH AND ALSO WITH HEAVY RAIN AT ISOLATED PLACES IN VIDARBHA .THUNDERSTORM ACCOMPANIED WITH LIGHTNING WITH HEAVY RAIN AT ISOLATED PLACES OVER CHATTISGARH.
28-Jun-2026 (Day 5)	THUNDERSTORM ACCOMPANIED WITH RAIN,LIGHTNING, GUSTY WINDS (SPEED REACHING 40-50 KMPH) LIKELY AT ISOLATED PLACES IN MADHYA PRADESH AND ALSO WITH HEAVY RAIN AT ISOLATED PLACES IN VIDARBHA .THUNDERSTORM ACCOMPANIED WITH LIGHTNING WITH HEAVY RAIN AT ISOLATED PLACES OVER CHATTISGARH.
